## FUEL SUPPLY & DISTRIBUTION: What You Need to Know...

**D**etermined to sanitize the prevailing fuel supply and distribution scenario across the country, the Nigerian National Petroleum Corporation, NNPC, has undertaken some measures to address the situation.

The steps are tailored to provide the public with unimpeded access to petroleum products while measures are being fast-tracked to address the challenge in the short, medium to long term basis.

### What we are doing..?

- Increasing supply of petrol from the initial one vessel per day to two vessels per day, effectively providing 100 million litres of petrol for discharge into the system every day.
- Fully deploying and activating 24 hours real-time Fuel War Room for effective monitoring of the fuel supply & distribution dynamics across the country.
- Sustaining 24 hours loading and sales operations in all our depots and mega stations respectively.
- Working with Officers and Men of the Nigerian Security and Civil Defence Corps, (NSCDC), to curtail diversion through escort of trucks and monitoring.
- Collaborating and sharing information with the oil industry regulator, the Department of Petroleum Resources, (DPR) who is responsible for price enforcement.
- Collaborating and sharing information with Security Agencies to expose and punish saboteurs involved in sharp practices.
- Working closely with the Petroleum Tanker Drivers, an arm of the National Union of Petroleum and Natural Gas Workers, (NUPENG), to ensure seamless movement of products nationwide.
- Inter-facing with the Major Oil Marketers Association of Nigeria, (MOMAN), the Depot and Petroleum Products Marketers Association, (DAPPMA) and the independent marketers that have supported the drive towards 24 hour operations.

### What other stakeholders need to do in the medium to long term...

- 24 hours improved border surveillance by the Nigerian Customs Service and other Security Agencies at the borders to curtail smugglers, driven mainly by huge price arbitrage.
- Dredging of the Escravos water channel by the Nigerian Ports Authority to facilitate free flow of vessels .
- Enforcement of ex-depot/pump price at the depots and retail outlets (N133.28/litre and N145/litre respectively) by the DPR Department of State security Service e.t.c.
- Repair of bad road portions along our major highways among other measures, starting with rehabilitation of Jeba-Mokwa and Aba-Ikot Ekpene Roads.
